

**EDUCATION PLUS CREDIT UNION
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURE**

Description of Programs

1. Up to eight \$500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors.
2. A \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to schools with an operational student-run credit union branch.
3. One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Monroe County Community College student. All requirements below do not apply. Contact the MCCC Financial Aid office for details on this scholarship.

Requirements

1. To qualify, the applicant must:
 - be a member in good standing of EPCU for a minimum of six months prior to the application deadline;
 - have attained at least a 2.5 (C+) grade point on the 4.0 (A) grade point scale for the first seven semesters of high school;
 - be enrolled in an accredited college or trade school for a minimum of nine semester hours or twelve quarter hours;
2. To be considered, the applicant must, no later than March 15th of each year:
 - complete and submit a scholarship application;
 - submit a written essay of at least 100 words explaining the applicant's life goals and reason for applying for a scholarship;
 - submit two written recommendations from the applicant's high school (counselor, teacher, principal, etc.);
 - submit official transcripts of the applicant's high school record.
3. If awarded a scholarship, the applicant must pay college expenses and submit receipts to EPCU for reimbursement. All receipts must be submitted prior to the end of the school year in which the scholarship was awarded.
4. Children of EPCU board members, supervisory committee members, credit committee members and employees are not eligible to apply for these scholarships.
